A brief description of our public body is as follows:

Purpose: Our purpose is to provide materials and services for the recreational, social, informational, and educational needs of the community.

Finance: The total amount of our operating budget for Fiscal Year 2018/2019 is: \$1,064,525. Funding sources are property taxes, state and Federal grants, fines, charges, and donations.

Location: The office is located at: 123 E. Scranton Avenue, Lake Bluff, IL 60044

Staffing: We employ approximately the following number of individuals: Full-time 8; Part-time 13.

Governance: The following organization exercises control over our policies and procedures: The Lake Bluff Public Library Board of Trustees. Meetings are held at the library at 7:00PM on the third Tuesday of each month.
