## **BORROW WITH** LIBBY/OVERDRIVE

Use the Libby app or **DLIL.Overdrive.com** to check out Kindle books.

### SEND TO KINDLE

Follow the prompts to send your ebooks to your Kindle wirelessly, or transfer with a USB.



# BORROWING EBOOKS



#### Borrow Kindle books through Libby

#### Getting started (on mobile/tablet)

- Install the **Libby** app from the app store on your device.
- 2. Follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.
- 3. Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
- 4. Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** ( ).

#### Getting started (on laptop/desktop)

- 1. Visit <u>DLIL.Overdrive.com</u> and click **Sign In**.
- Select your home library from the drop down menu. Enter your library card number and click Sign In.
- 3. Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
- 4. Borrowed titles appear on your **Loans** page. Click on the icon to see your loans.

## SEND TO KINDLE

**WIRELESS** 

### Send ebooks to your Kindle wirelessly through Amazon

- 1. On your **Shelf** or **Loans**, locate the title and select **Read now with Kindle**.
- 2. You'll be taken to Amazon's website to finish getting the ebook. Make sure you are signed into the Amazon account connected to your Kindle.
- 3. Verify the **Deliver to:** device is set as your Kindle and select **Get Library Book**.
- 4. Your Kindle ereader needs a Wi-Fi connection to download library Kindle Books from Amazon. You may need to sync your device in the **Settings** for the book to load.

Note: If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, you'll need to transfer the title via USB (see the next page).

## TRANSFER TO KINDLE USB

### Transfer ebooks to your Kindle via USB cord

- Connect your Kindle to your computer with the USB cord.
- 2. On Amazon's website, go to your **Content and Devices** page, found in your Account menu.
- 3. Find the title in the **Content** list and select **More Actions** or the •••• icon.
- 4. Select **Download & transfer via USB** in the popup window.
- 5. Follow Amazon's prompts to finish the transfer.

## RETURN OR RENEW

#### Return

Ebooks will return automatically at the end of the loan period, but you can manually return them early.

You can return Kindle Books like any other book in Libby or on <u>DLIL.Overdrive.com</u>.

If you'd prefer, you can return Kindle Books from Amazon instead:

- 1. Go to your **Manage Your Content and Devices** page on Amazon.
- 2. Find the title in the **Content** list and select ....
- 3. Select **Return this book** in the pop-up window.
- 4. Select **Yes** to confirm and return the book.

#### Renew

- 1. Renew the title in Libby or on <a href="DLIL.Overdrive.com">DLIL.Overdrive.com</a>.
- On Amazon's website, go to Manage Your Content and Devices.
- 3. Under **Content**, select and delete the title.
- 4. Go back to Libby or DLIL.Overdrive.com and deliver the Kindle Book to your Amazon account again using the Send/Transfer to Kindle instructions.
