

LIBBY



Access ebooks, audiobooks, and magazines

Getting started

- Install the **Libby** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
- 2. In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.
- 3. Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
- 4. Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

More you can do

On your **Shelf ()**, tap **Loans** at the top of the screen. From there, you can:

- Tap Read With... to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle or Libby
- Tap Open In Libby to start reading or listening in the app
- Tap Manage Loan to see options like Renew Loan and Return Early

HOOPLA



Access ebooks, audiobooks, comics, movies, and music

Getting started

- 1. Install the **Hoopla** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
- 2. Sign up with your library card and create an account. You'll use the username and password you set to log into Hoopla going forward.
- 3. Browse the collection and borrow a title.

 Remember, each person is limited to <u>8 borrows</u>

 <u>per month</u>, so choose carefully!
- 4. Tap **Read** or **Play** to enjoy!

More you can do

- Tap on Borrowed to view your current titles
- Use the Search function to look up titles
- Tap the icon next to a title to add it to your
 Favorites
- Tap on Download to your device for offline use

KANOPY



Access movies and TV shows

Getting started

- 1. Install the **Kanopy** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
- 2. Swipe through the welcome pages and tap on **Sign Up**.
- Create your Kanopy account, either through your Google or Facebook login, or directly on Kanopy using your email address and password.
- 4. You will receive a verification email at the address you used to sign up click the link in the email to verify your address.
- 5. Follow the prompts on the app to choose your library and add your card information.
- 6. You're all set! Select a film to start watching. Each person has <u>8 plays per month</u>, so choose carefully!

- Tap the <u>icon</u> icon to access your Watchlist or browse genres

Getting started with the Flipster app

- Install the Flipster app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
- 2. Open the app and tap Get Started.
- 3. Share your location or search manually for Lake Bluff Public Library. Tap **Select This Library**.
- 4. Enter your library card number and tap Sign In.
- 5. Browse the collection and choose titles to download. Magazines check out for 7 days.

Getting started in browser

- 1. Visit <u>LakeBluffLibrary.org/Ebooks</u> and click on **Flipster**.
- 2. Enter your library card number and click Log In.
- 3. Browse the collection and click on a cover to open a magazine. Magazines check out for 7 days.
