LIBBY



Access ebooks, audiobooks, comics, and magazines

Getting started

- 1. Install the **Libby** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
- 2. In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.
- 3. Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.
- 4. Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

More you can do

On your **Shelf (**), tap **Loans** at the top of the screen. From there, you can:

- Tap **Read With...** to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle or Libby
- Tap Open In Libby to start reading or listening in the app
- Tap Manage Loan to see options like Renew
 Loan and Return Early

HOOPLA

Access ebooks, audiobooks, comics, movies, and music

Getting started

- 1. Install the **Hoopla** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
- 2. Sign up with your library card and create an account. You will use the username and password you set to log into Hoopla going forward.
- 3. Browse the collection and borrow a title. Remember, each person is limited to <u>6 borrows</u> <u>per month</u>, so choose carefully.
- 4. Tap Read or Play to enjoy!

More you can do

- Tap on My hoopla to view your current titles
- Use the **Search** function to look up titles
- Tap the icon next to a title to add it to your
 Favorites
- Tap on **Download to your device** for offline use

Getting started

- 1. Install the **Kanopy** app from the Amazon Appstore on your Fire tablet.
- 2. Swipe through the welcome pages and tap on **Sign Up**.
- 3. Create your Kanopy account using your email address and a password.
- 4. You will receive a verification email at the address you used to sign up - click the link in the email to verify your address.
- 5. Follow the prompts on the app to choose your library and add your card information.
- 6. You're all set! Select a film to start watching. Each person has <u>24 tickets per month</u>. Ticket cost varies by item.

 Watchlist
