Play with toys, puppets, puzzles, blocks or magna-tiles.




Pick up crafts to take home.

Attend programs like Storytime or Lego club.




Use the youth activity room as a quiet space if I need to.



Check out books, movies or CDs, audiobooks, puzzles, Launchpads or STEAM/STEM kits.




When it is time to check out, I will go upstairs with my adult to the circulation desk.
